In our search for great destinations that tie in with an equally enticing drive, we visit The Cliff House in Ogunquit, Maine.


The Cliff House Resort & Spa is situated on 70 oceanfront acres, high atop Bald Head Cliff on Maine's southern coast. Located about an hour north of Boston, and less than five hours from New York City, it is one New England's most spectacular—and relaxing—locations.

This family-owned property opened in 1872 and has been welcoming guests each season, April to November, for 139 years. Steeped in history while offering luxurious accommodations the resort has 166 guest rooms with picture windows and decks for viewing the wide-open Atlantic.

The adults-only spa building opened in 2002 and is home to New England's first oceanfront spa. The full-service spa specializes in unique treatments

as well as traditional massage, skin care and nail services. Indigenous ingredients like blueberries, Maine wild roses, juniper, seashells and sea stones inspire the treatment menu. Just outside the spa is an oceanfront pool with vanishing edge and seaside labyrinth based on the labyrinth at the 13th century French cathedral at Chartres.

The Cliff House offers fine and casual, ocean-view dining options with menus based on Maine-raised and locally grown products. For the 2011 season, the chef has created an innovative "Lobster Five Way" menu that uses Maine's favorite delicacy in unexpected and delicious ways. This fall, guests can enjoy popular wine and microbrew tasting weekend getaways with specials menus and special package pricing.

Maine's south coast offers a myriad of activities to enjoy from outlet and boutique shopping to beaches, golf, hiking, ocean cruises, museums, theaters and more. The Cliff House provides a luxurious place to stay while enjoying these area attractions and relaxing seaside.
