## Mt. Agamenticus

Directions from Cliff House

### **20-minute drive**

- ↩ Turn left onto Shore Rd 2.4mi.
- ↪ Turn right onto River Rd. Continue to follow River Rd. 1.0 mi.
- ↪ Turn right onto US-1 N 0.3 mi
- ↩ Turn left onto Agamenticus Rd.1.5 mi.
- ↪ Turn right to stay on Agamenticus Rd/Mountain Rd. Continue to follow Mountain Road 2.6mi.
- ↪ Turn right onto Mount Agamenticus Rd. Destination will be on the right 0.6 mi.



“The Mount Agamenticus Conservation Region consists of more than 10,000 acres and is located within an additional 30,000-acre expanse of conservation land in southern Maine. This land is comprised of a rich and unique coastal forest that supports the highest diversity of animal and plant species in all of Maine. The mountain and the surrounding area provide residents with an ideal location for hiking, biking and sightseeing.”

### A few simple rules...

- **Carry in-Carry out** Trash receptacles are not provided.
- **Use trails for their designed purpose** Respect others on the trail
- **Stay on open trails**
- **Wetlands and vernal pools are fragile** Please do not disturb them
- **Do not cut, dig or collect plant life, animal life or cultural artifacts**
- **No campfires or camping**
- **Respect private property**

## Cliff House Trails

### Cliff Walk

*With views of the majestic Atlantic Ocean, take a relaxing stroll around our property using the Cliff Walk. At only .51 miles the walk begins just in front of our Weare Cottage and wraps around our property with your choice of stopping at the staircase to the rocks, our North Point Lawn, to take in the views, or continuing back to our main entrance.*

*\*Reception to North Point Lawn is .16 miles*

### Nature Trail

*If you are looking to explore nature, check out our trailhead guide just past our Weare Cottage. This loop will take you past our fern garden, through our herb and vegetable gardens, and back to the resort. Keep an eye out for some deer tracks!*

*\*One loop is a half mile. Sturdy Footwear recommended*
